Keep in touch with Professor Ioannis Spilanis who presented on statistical indicators (we met him in Kastellorizo in 2015).

AOB: membership requests	thresholds for State Aid and De Minimis.  - Camille met Tony Zammit from Gozo who is interested in setting up an informal network for island scientific issues (Researchgate island platform) – Tony will forward some details to us.  - Requests from the Gozo Federation of local Association via its president Ryan Mercieca and from Marie-Galante (small island off Guadeloupe in the Caribbean) (see link to CPMR ppt about the island here) represented at the CPMR event to join ESIN – were discussed. It was pointed out that both islands have very large populations (32 000 and 12 000) and that representation would not be from a federation but from one island only. Whilst networking and sharing across all islands is to be welcomed, we must be mindful not to lose ESIN's distinct focus which is to provide a voice and representation for European small islands. Agreed that 'associate' membership should be explored as an alternative option to full membership.	Camille will circulate Tony Zammit proposal when received.  ESIN will look at proposal to add associate membership to ESIN statutes.  Associate Membership would need to be brought up for and agreed at AGM.
