European Commission

- Equipment and installation costs (CAPEX)
- Up to 100 % of total project cost
- € 15.000 max. / Municipality



Public Bodies

- Subscriptions to the ISP-Telecom operator (OPEX)
- At least 3 years in operation
- No commercial use



National Regulatory Authorities

 Removing regulatory obstacles to Wi-Fi deployment and quality of service



Simple & non-bureaucratic: an applicant-friendly scheme

- Online applications
- Light decision making
- Payment by vouchers
- Remote and real-time monitoring

Registration

Once the portal opens registration is possible for:

- municipalities
- Wi-Fi installation companies

No need to "rush": registration can be done any time, valid for all 5 calls for projects.









As soon as a call opens, the municipalities can apply:

- Open your registration ("my account")
- Be quick to click "apply":

First come, first served!

<u>first come, first served</u> application time







geographically balanced each country gets

- at least 15 vouchers
- max. 8% of the budget

- Municipalities choose 'main centre of public life'
- Municipalities choose their installation company.

Payment

- Municipality sends the voucher to the installation company
- 2. Commission verifies the Wi-Fi hotspot is operating
- Installation company redeems the voucher to the Commission



WiFi4EU Hotspot


Municipality pays for the subscription.

WiFi4EU hotspot must be operational for 3 years (minimum).





First Call Timeline





First call

(CEF Work Programme 2017)


- Budget: € 15 million;
- Voucher value: € 15,000 per municipality



- Applicants:

- Associations formed by Municipalities



Complementary with EU funding



ESIF, CEF and **EFSI** can support the backhaul network

(National/Regional Broadband Plans)

WiFi4EU will support the Wi-Fi access points (Local authority initiative)
