### 1. Minutes, Agenda and Matters Arising

John Walsh opened the meeting. The minutes of 20 Jan 2020 were approved as was the agenda for this meeting Pro: Camille Second: Kristian. SEARICA to be discussed in AOB

### 2. Finance

- Annette will send out Membership invoices. FEDARENE has been paid the €750 fee leaving €2,428.14 in the ESIN account.
- ACTION: RT to send Annette signed copy of AGM Minutes as well as John's contact information.
- If all members pay there will be a gain of €2,750. Annette to send 2019 and 2020 invoices to those unpaid.
- Need to achieve the 2020 budget of €2,750 plus existing €2,428.14 to allow for the AGM in Brussels
- ACTION: <u>AGM Budget needs to be defined</u>: AGM working group to meet ASAP to research prices, etc.
- Tentative cost per attendee €400.
- ACTION: Denis B to research getting the same conference room. <u>AGREED</u>: to aim for the same general set-up as the last Brussels AGM
- PROPOSED: Maximum of 500euro from ESIN for the 2020 AGM AGREED.

• PROPOSED: A separate funding for ESIN member(s) to attend outside meetings as preagreed by the Board – a sum of 2,000euro from budget. AGREED.

#### 3. Review of Action Points & Conferences

- 1. John is writing to Italy concerning their membership with regard to payments and participation. There has been no response from Denis Baric: Annette will send Croatia the 2020 invoice. ACTION: JW and RT to write letter.
- 2. Working Groups: The Terms of Reference have been completed. Each group is to meet and send forms back in to the Board. ACTION: Put Working Group information in DropBox. Plastics & Waste: It was suggested that Blue Growth program, which includes plastics & waste, is more important and should have its own working group. ACTION: Camille to send info on Blur Growth to all to enable a decision.
- 3. Europe for Citizens: Research how difficult it is to apply for funding especially as it has been suggested that the program will change at the beginning of 2021. ACTION: JW to email Pia to see will she speak with Kim: Lise and Dorthe to also discuss with Kim if there is the opportunity.
- 4. Letter to MEPs: ACTION: To be put into Strategy Group. All to look over letter and send suggestions in to CD.
- 5. Island Tax Structures: Existing tax benefits on EU Islands?
  - Denmark: free ferry for residents, reduced cargo rates
  - Scotland: incentives for employing on Islands remotely
  - PROPOSED: Useful to compile any legislation relevant to Islands: re positive discrimination also loss of allowances over the years. ACTION: Policy/ strategy group to look at tax structures, etc. Lise to set up questionnaire on Google analytics; CD to add Rural questionnaire.

### 4. Chair Update

- John to send on report on Smart Villages: it is important for each member to know their local Smart Village actions.
- More work needed on Smart Islands: John to write to Tonino Picula before end of Croatian Presidency
- Meeting with Irish MEP Billy Kelleher: very positive; keen to see a doc on ESIN needs and suggested solutions. ACTION: Policy group to work on list of needs and solutions for MEPs.
   Also, Denis B to speak with Giuseppe Sciacca re Smart Islands work in CPMR.
- Meeting at the Secretariat: JW&CD: could be an extension to Secretariat in June which may be permanent. NESOI: 60x€50,000 grants available in October for energy projects.
- Youth rep? Proposed: a short film from each Federation by youth expressing their views on Climate Change AGREED: Add to the questionnaire - questions on Youth involvement and interest
- Advisory Board of Secretariat: John to attend 25 March in Brussels, expenses paid by Secretariat.
  - Very little, if anything, from the Secretariat or NESOI for the small Islands. No answer to questioning of whether the small Islands can be included

- Message to bring to Advisory: Small Islands have serious funding difficulties so almost impossible for them to even write an energy plan. Without funding and technical help they will not progress to clean energy.
- **ACTION**: Note to lobby for ELENA funding to include a section for small Island funding
